


*Census Blocks(GeoID: 482013433021000), (GeoID: 482013433021000), and (GeoID: 482013433021024) were split along parcel boundaries south of North H Street and again southward to include all of the Large Lot Subdivision to add territory to District 1 from District 4. Address points for residential locations were summed for that area and then multiplied by 2.61 (persons per household from the 2020 Census calculated as: 35,124 persons/13,481 households) for a total of approximately 212 persons.


These 212 persons were added to District 1 as being representative of the territory moving from District 4 to District 1. Additionally 212 persons were subtracted from District 4 as being representative of the territory being removed from District 4.

Upon splitting the Census geography, no further demographics other than total population can be reported for Districts 1 and 4. 2020 Census is reported for Districts 2, 3, 5, and 6. Estimated population is reported for Districts 1 and 4.
